NO GIMMIES

Every ball must be holed out, regardless of distance.

NOTES

LOCAL RULES

THE GREEN

One permanent cup shared by all nine holes.
The green is retained by a brown stone wall about three feet tall. Every hole must carry it.

BLACK RIVER — PENALTY AREA

Driveway, road and parking, mapped as one river.
A ball in Black River may not be played as it lies.
One penalty stroke. Drop within one club length of the nearest dry ground where the ball last crossed the edge, no nearer the hole.

MAV'S WATER HOLE — PENALTY AREA

The pool. Not played as it lies. One penalty stroke; drop on the nearest playable grass to the point of entry, no nearer the hole.

HOUSE & PATIO — PENALTY ZONE

Not played as they lie. Relief for one penalty stroke.

CART PATH & MULCH BEDS — FREE RELIEF

One club length, no nearer the hole, no penalty.
Exception: the east mulch bed is played as it lies.

THE GARDEN — NO PLAY ZONE

A ball in the Garden must not be played. Free relief: place a ball in the Garden Drop Zone. Relief is mandatory even if the ball lay nearer the hole.

THE WOODS

Playable if found. Not found is lost — stroke and distance.

TEEING AREAS

Played from the surface they sit on. Hole 7 tees directly off mulch. No improving the lie.

THE FIRE PIT

First tee shot into the Inner Circle:
par 3 — automatic birdie · par 4 — automatic eagle.
A second tee shot earns no score but takes free relief within one club length — the only relief on the course allowed nearer the hole.

HOW ASHMONT IS PLAYED

Ashmont has nine permanent teeing areas and one permanent cup. Every hole finishes in the same cup.
Play from the marked tee until the ball is holed, record the score, then walk to the next tee.
Holes 5 and 9 are measured along their playing routes — the direct line is obstructed on both.
